

Appendix G — Recommended Contents of PPH Cart/Box

Airway and breathing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Adult airways • Oxygen mask and tubing • Intubation/ventilation supplies (or accessible code cart)
Medications	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Uterotonics • Tranexamic Acid (TXA) • Clear instructions of location of refrigerated PPH medications • Local anesthetic for suture/repairs • Medication labels
Intravenous supplies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Large bore intravenous cannulas • IV extension sets • Skin cleanser (alcohol and/or prepared chlorhexidine swabs) • Tourniquet • Intravenous tubings • Crystalloid intravenous solutions • Syringes and needles • Securement system (tegaderm, tape) • Blood collection tubes and syringes • Blood transfusion set • Pressure infuser supplies • Blood warmer supplies (if available)
Additional equipment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Basic scale and container for weighing blood loss amounts • Bright task light and speculum light • Sterile gloves (assorted sizes) • PPE • Manual BP & stethoscope (or electronic VS monitor immediately available) • Foley catheter and urinary bag • Skin cleanser (as per local protocol) • Surgical sutures (assorted sizes/types) • Gauze, tape • Vaginal and uterine packing (radiopaque) • Surgical towels • Intrauterine inflatable balloon (i.e. Bakri®) • Pelvic speculum • Weighted speculum • Vaginal retractors • Sponge forceps • Needle forceps • Tissue forceps
Documentation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Quantitative Blood Loss Worksheets • Table of dry weights (common pads, soakers, collection containers, gauze, sponges, surgical towels) • Intake and output forms • Additional variance/progress notes • Consent forms (for blood products or surgical procedures)
